Rest homes provide a supervised, supportive, and protected living environment for individuals having difficulty caring for themselves and who do not require nursing care or other medical services on a regular basis. Accommodations in a rest home may include: private or shared bathrooms, living rooms, and dining rooms. Rest home staff provide residents with personal care, medication management, some housekeeping, and 24-hour staffing. Rest homes are licensed by the Department of Public Health and are inspected yearly.
